This application serves as a full liability waiver of all parties involved in hosting the residency including Stonehenge Reserve, Tankwa Tented Camp, AIRSA and all individuals in any capacity.

Documentation & Commercial use

In addition all participating artists consent to being filmed and their work documented for non-commercial purposes. All work produced or intended for commercial purposes subsequent to the residency needs to be negotiated in advance to include AIRSA as a 25% beneficiary (or gallery equivalent) of any sales or commercial use of media or artworks produced during the course of the residency. We advise doing so through a Creative Commons Licence.

Our documenters are volunteers and any media used must have proper attribution. If you would like a copy of images or media produced through the course of residency please bring an external Mac compatible device, since we are remote, providing large media files subsequent to the residency is challenging. Artworks intended to remain in the landscape will be cared for and maintained within reason by Stonehenge Reserve in partnership with AIRSA and the artist if stipulated, understanding that some work is intended to be ephemeral while "permanent" artworks exposed to the extreme environment will degrade over time. Artwork that is considered to have lost its original integrity will be evaluated and respectfully removed over time if necessary.
